

M.O.R.E 2 Dance Studio Rules

Dance is an art form of great discipline, this includes punctuality, respect for the art form, respect for your teacher, for your fellow students and for your studio. Time is so precious and “time flies when you’re having fun”, wasting time is not acceptable and there will be consequences for doing so. So please be on time and enter the studio focused and ready to learn. Listed below are my rules and expectations.

Studio Rules and Expectations...

- 1). Bullying will not be tolerated.
- 2). No bad language should be used.
- 3). Time wasting, distracting others, failure to listen and participate. These are all disruptive behaviors and will not be tolerated.
- 4). Please be respectful of the studio, there are many of us sharing this space therefore I ask that you keep the studio clean and tidy.
- 5). Adherence to dress code and grooming is expected.
- 6). We are all here to learn and have fun, therefore I expect and encourage you to watch your peers and feel free to applaud, and share in each others accomplishments.
- 7). I welcome questions during class that apply to the topic on hand and likewise I will ask you questions too, however, questions pertaining to topics outside of the classroom will not be answered during class time.
- 8). I expect you to give 100% or more every class, this is how you will learn and improve ... there is no such thing as a “lazy dancer”.
- 9). If you have an existing injury or you have a pain, please let me know at the beginning of class or when that pain occurs.
- 10). Remember that we are all different and unique, some more sensitive, some more shy, some more outgoing, some more confident. If you have a miss understanding or upset someone, remember that now matter how different we all are we all have feelings and saying sorry goes a long way!

Consequences if rules are continually broken...

- You may be asked to sit out of the class.
- You may not be able to participate in shows.
- You may be suspended for 1, 2, or 3 weeks. (no refunds would be offered for missing those weeks)
- Your participation as a More2Dance student may be terminated. (no refund of tuition paid or payable).
